Each drivers best 2 results from the 3 Heats will be added together with the championship points awarded on the table this produces.

There is 2 bonus points for the fastest lap of EACH heat.

Example.

If a Driver 1 comes 1st, 9th and 5th they would drop the heat they finished 9th in. Resulting in a 1st and 5th meaning points of 18 and 8, so a total score of 26.

If driver 2 comes 3rd 4th and 4th they would drop one of the 4th place results. Resulting in a 3rd and 4th meaning points of 12 and 10, so a total score of 22.

This would mean Driver 1 is first and Driver 2 is second in the event and this would be how the championship points are awarded.

If any drivers are tied on race points, this will be sorted by who set the fastest lap between them on that night.

To keep things fair and to remove the kart differences even more, each driver will start each race from a different kart, in a different position. One race Starting towards the front, One from the middle, one from the back.

This will be done in the following format, which ensures every driver starts from an average middle position over the 3 races. (EXAMPLE FOR 10 DRIVERS)

The drivers positions will be directly linked to the current WKRKC, So Driver 1 will be the person leading the Championship, Driver 2 the person in 2nd, Driver 3 the person in 3rd and so on.

Any new drivers who are not yet on the Championship table will always take the lowest available positions.

Racing Rules:

All Wight karting rules to be followed as standard.

Blue flags will be used and waved at drivers who are being lapped.

Drivers being blue flagged must move off the racing line and allow the lead car through. Black flags will be given to drivers who do not.
